Give my regards to everyone.

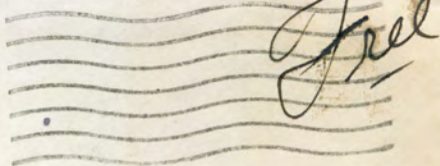
