

Kuschwarda im Böhmerwalde
Czechoslovakia
August 2, 1945

Dear Flo, Leo, and Ina,

Your letter of June 18th finally caught up to me. Since my last letter we have moved again. We're still in Czechoslovakia, but we are in the part called Sudetenland, the people here speak strictly German - in more than (one) sense of the word they are Germans.

We were told that our outfit is scheduled to sail for home sometime in December or January, that is if the plans aren't changed. It's still quite sometime off, but at least we're going and that's what counts.

Glad to hear Berth is well, he's probably on his way home, well, he's home now. I just remembered a letter from the folks told me about it. I think he'll get a 60 day furlough if they haven't changed the ruling (it's a 60 day furlough for prisoners of war who were prisoners for over 60 days).

I haven't heard too much news from home lately, so there really isn't much to tell you.

I guess that's all for now, will write again soon. Regards to all.
